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

Introduction



- In osteopathy and chiropractic, serious adverse events are rare, candour events are more likely to centre around uncertainty.
- Work needed to explore the definition of candour as understood by patients, specifically better understanding of:
 - Patient expectations in these circumstances
 - How patients can be supported to be partners in their care before, during and after, if things go wrong.



What we did

22 participants in total...

A deliberative workshop conducted in September 2023.

This approach built participant knowledge and used a range of hypothetical scenarios to help bring the topic to life. 16 patients were recruited to match a pre-agreed specification: 12 chiropractic & 4 osteopathic patients


6 members attended – one carer and 5 osteopathic patients GOsC Patient Involvement Forum












For osteopaths
